

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ELECTRIC POE

**NEW THIS YEAR!** Tickets are sold on an individual basis and not as plots.

Bring your own chairs (**BLANKET SEATING IS NOT AVAILABLE**) or

Leave the chairs to us and **Purchase Reserved Seating!**

- **Check in will open 30 minutes before showtime** - This is a **ticketless special event**. Please provide your E-Ticket via mobile device or as a printout at check in. Check in will be located at the front gate.
- There is **NO LATE SEATING** allowed. The gates to the cemetery will be closed when the show begins and will not reopen until the show concludes.
- **Parking is not allowed within the cemetery gates** – you may park in the outlined spots just outside of the gates and walk in. While the path is paved to the check in table, there is **uneven terrain** to the seating area that some might find difficult or inaccessible.
- At this time, based on CDC guidelines, we **HIGHLY RECOMMEND** that **ALL patrons and staff wear face masks over their nose and mouth when not seated**.
- Please maintain social distance between you/your group and other groups/staff.
- **If you purchased Reserved Seating**, chairs will be provided, and your seat assignments will be determined by order date. You will find your name on the back of your chair(s). Reserved seating will have at least one chair width of distance between each set of reserved seats.
- **General Admission seating is BYOC (Bring Your Own Chairs)** and will be allowed in any available space (outside of the reserved seating section). Please leave a bit of distance between yourselves and others and be careful as you maneuver around the tombstones. **Blanket seating is not available**.
- **Food is ONLY allowed** at the picnic tables (located just across from the Sexton's Cottage) and to be consumed prior to the start of the performance. **Drinks are allowed** at your seats.
- Please take all trash with you and deposit it into trash receptacles as you exit.
- **Running Time is approximately 45 minutes**, followed by an optional Q&A with performers & historian.
- If anyone feels ill on the day of the performance, please stay home, and contact the box office at 816-474-6552 to exchange your tickets to a future performance or to receive a link to view the performance from the comfort of your own home.
- **Accessible seating/parking:** Due to the historic nature of Union Cemetery, some might find the terrain difficult or inaccessible. The path to the seating area is not paved. For information on special needs seating/parking please contact the Box Office at 816-474-6552.
- **How to Get Here:** Union Cemetery is located just south of Crown Center and southeast of the National WW1 Museum & Memorial in the historic Union Hill neighborhood at 227 E 28th Terr Kansas City, MO 64108.
- **Concerned about the forecast?** Should a decision be made to cancel a performance because of weather conditions, a notice will be posted on the Coterie's Facebook page, and we will send an email to all ticket holding patrons. The decision to cancel will be made no later than two hours before showtime. If a performance is canceled, we will happily reschedule your party for another performance.
