<u>Kansas City, MO</u> – The Coterie Theatre continues its 40th season of live theatre for families and young audiences with the musical adaptation of the beloved book, *Mr. Popper's Penguins*, for families with ages seven and older. It tells the adventures of Mr. & Mrs. Popper when a mysterious box on their doorstep leads to a house full of penguins and worldwide adventures. *Mr. Popper's Penguins* is directed by Heidi Van and will be performed live on The Coterie's stage, February 26 – March 31, 2019.

THE PLAY

In this charming musical adaptation of the beloved book, Mr. Popper longs to see the world, have fantastic adventures, find undiscovered continents, and to study penguins. But life for Mr. and Mrs. Popper takes on more adventure than they ever expected when an unexpected box arrives on their doorstep courtesy of Admiral Drake, the world famous explorer. Inside the box is none other than a penguin – a penguin sent from the South Pole that they name Captain Cook and let sleep in their refrigerator. However, with penguins being the social creatures they are, the local aquarium sends over a female penguin and soon the Poppers are hearing the patter of 20 little feet. When the Popper house goes from one penguin living in the icebox to a whole family of penguins who all have to be fed, they form a touring act and take "Popper's Performing Penguins" on the road! What begins for Mr. & Mrs. Popper as a giant bill for canned shrimp leads to an imaginative journey from Vaudeville to the Antarctic.

Mr. Popper's Penguins is adapted from the best-selling children's novel by Richard & Florence Atwater first published in 1938. Since winning the prestigious Newbery Honor Award, given for excellence in children's literature, in 1939, the book has become a classic of family reading and has now been adapted to a delightful stage musical with book by Robert Kauzlaric and music and lyrics by George Howe. This new whimsical take on the popular story made its premiere in 2015 at Lifeline Theatre in Chicago and features showtunes and puppets to bring the south pole wildlife to life on stage. In its review of the premiere production, the *Chicago Reader* raved, "... [an] endearing and enduring tale... This charming and funny hour-long family show, which uses life-size puppets to represent the birds, emphasizes the loving partnership of Mr. Popper and his improbably patient and supportive wife... [a] witty script and [a] bouncy score..."

Mr. Popper's Penguins will run approximately 65 minutes with no intermission and can be enjoyed by families with ages seven and older. The Coterie is funded in part by the Missouri Arts Council, ArtsKC Fund, and Theater League.

The cast of *Mr. Popper's Penguins* will feature Seth Jones (as Mr. Popper), Elise Poehling (as Mrs. Popper), Roan Ricker (as Mr. Johnson, Admiral Drake, Delivery Guy, Barber, Reporter, Policeman, Bus Driver, Theatre Manager, Sven Svenson), Antonia Washington (as Mrs. Callahan, Gentleman, Curator, Passenger, Mr. Greenbaum, Cab Driver, Copper), and Faith "Phoenix" Johnson and Ashley Elliott-Rowe (as Penguin Puppeteers). The artistic and production company includes Heidi Van (director), Danielle Renee (production stage manager), Scott Hobart (set designer, technical director), Jarrett Bertoncin (lighting designer), Georgianna Londré Buchanan (costume designer), David Kiehl (sound designer), Joyce Merrill (properties/set dressing), and Taylor Jene Sullvan (production assistant).

SHOW DATES, TIMES & TICKETS

The Coterie, now in its 40th Season and named "One of the Five Best Theaters for Young Audiences in the U.S." by *TIME* magazine, will perform *Mr. Popper's Penguins* February 26 – March 31, 2019, in The Coterie Theatre, located on level one of the Crown Center shops in Kansas City, MO. Press Night will be held on Friday, March 1, 2019, at 7:00 p.m.

Individual Tickets: Tickets are \$13.00 for youth under 18, students, and seniors age 60 and older; and \$17.00 for adults.

Subscriptions: In lieu of season subscriptions, The Coterie offers the Spotlight Pass, which works like a season ticket without committing to a set schedule. Spotlight Pass holders pay \$110.00 for a flexible pass that includes 10 tickets that can be used for any show or combination of the shows remaining in the 2018/2019 Season.

Group Pricing: The Coterie offers groups of 20 or more a special preview rate of \$5.00 per person the first week of each production. After preview week, groups pay only \$5.00 - \$8.00 per person depending on performance date.






